

“Seaero” Extras

- 2 ICOM marine radios, one at flybridge with DSC capabilities and one at lower helm station
- Explorer 660 Navigation system on flybridge
- Marine AM-FM/CD player radio in cabin with two speakers (can be set to play on flybridge)
- White cotton curtains with lighthouse themed trim for inside cabin windows
- Heavy duty canvas curtains for bunk and head porthole windows
- Carpets include:
 - 6 by 9 outdoor carpet for back deck
 - Round lighthouse wool rug for inside cabin
 - Short beige runner for inside cabin
 - Long beige runner for inside cabin
- 2 folding wooden Muskoka chairs with pads for back deck
- 2 folding armless wooden chairs for back deck
- Wooden table with shelf and Plexiglass on top for back deck
- Plastic drawer sets for storage in head
- Wooden shelved spice rack in galley
- Magazine holder in salon
- 4 canvas bags for back deck railings to hold shore power, water hoses, etc.
- 2 fire extinguishers
- 2 pike poles
- Heaving buoy and line
- Flare gun case
- Compass on flybridge
- Ray Marine Depth sounder on flybridge
- Three anchors with rode in bow anchor locker
- Water pressure system for hooking directly into water source at marinas
- Extra strut
- Extra transmission
- Extra distributor
- 2 water pumps
- Battery charger - attached to boat
- 4 automatic bilge pumps - 2/10,000 gallon and 2/5000 gallon
- Hand bailer
- Electrical 15 and 30-amp cheater cords along with regular shore power cords
- 2 storage nets to hang on bunk walls above berths
- 2 lifejackets carry bags that include:
 - 2 inflatables with extra carbons and information on maintenance

- Mustang coat
- Other Lifejackets/PFDs
- Record book containing information and statistics on vessel including listings of all work done to vessel
- Decorative Items include:
 - Captain's Box on shelf in cabin forward of dinette
 - Lamp with wooden boat shade on shelf in cabin forward of dinette
 - Wood slat box with lid
 - Wicker shelf on wall in port berth
 - Key box with knots on front in galley
 - Metal and plastic dish rack
 - Original advertising flyer for Richardson Boats circa 1962
 - Richardson History book including a chapter on AVRO aluminium hulled vessels
- Also available – folding table unit that pops up to create a dining table with four seats and a matching umbrella to put on table manufactured in British Columbia. Perfect when docked at a site with no picnic table!
